Ahsan Danish presented a scholarly paper on "A Critical Study of the Short Stories of Siraj."


Ms. Ghulam Sakeena Vesar shared a personal reflection titled "Muhanjo Jadugar Mehboob Siraj."


In 2024, Lucky Qindeel Panhwar and Sidarat ul Muntaha were selected to represent IYWO in the 5-day leadership experience.
